How can you help?

The NHS belongs to us all and we need to work together to reduce waste where we can. Medicines such as paracetamol and ibuprofen can be around four times more expensive when prescribed on the NHS compared to when they are bought in pharmacies and supermarkets.

Last year, prescriptions for paracetamol cost the NHS in south east Essex £362,000.

Medicines you can find over-the-counter:

- Cough and cold remedies
- Antihistamines (allergy conditions)
- Nasal sprays
- Indigestion remedies
- Short-term pain relief e.g. paracetamol
- Head lice remedies
- Haemorrhoids (piles) medication
- Teething remedies

1. Visit Pharmacy Arrange a Medication Review with your local pharmacist.

2. Consultation

They will either see you straight away or arrange for a time for you to visit.

3. Medicine Review

You will get a chance to ask questions about what you're taking and why, and receive advice.
